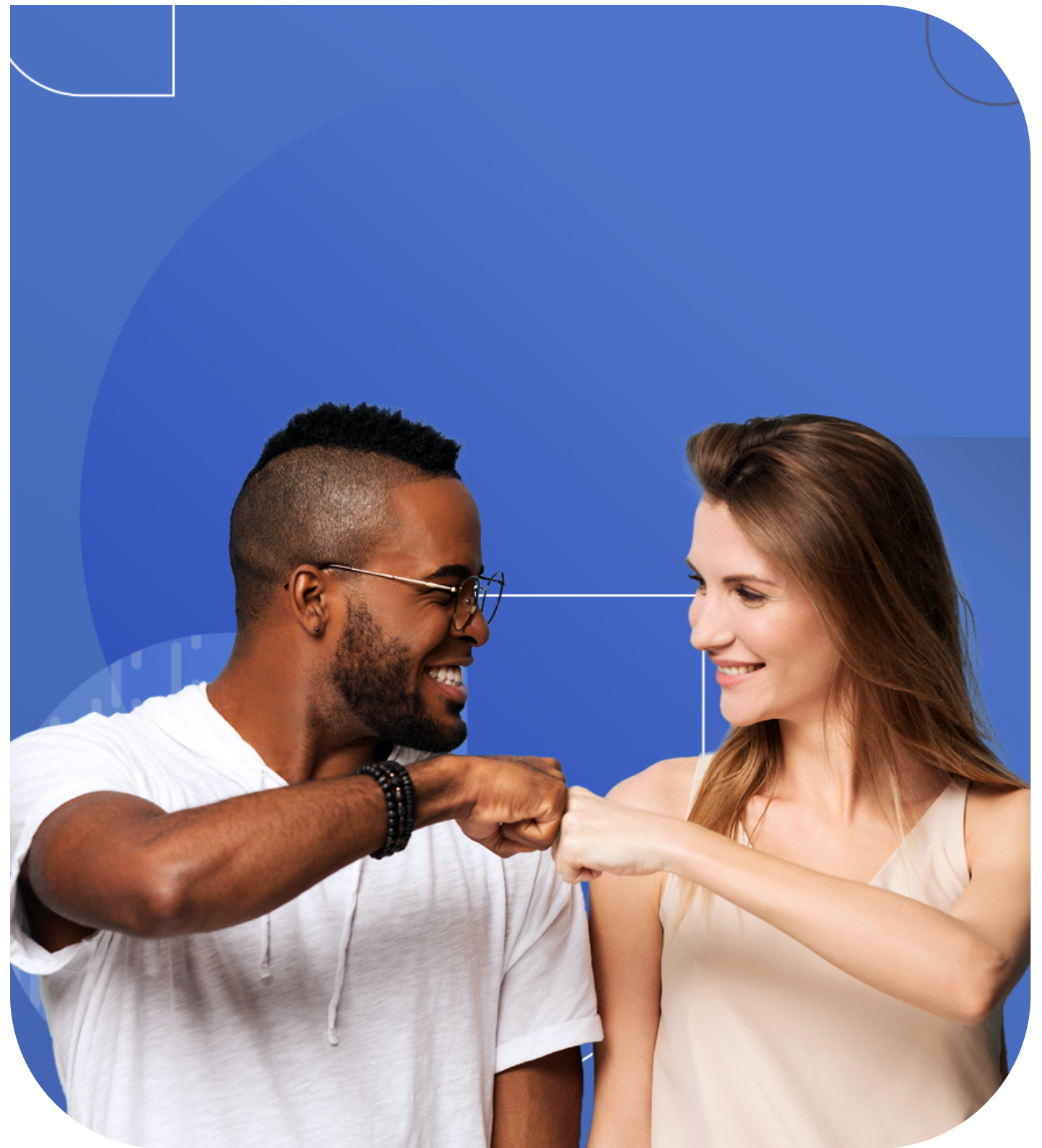
## New in 2024!

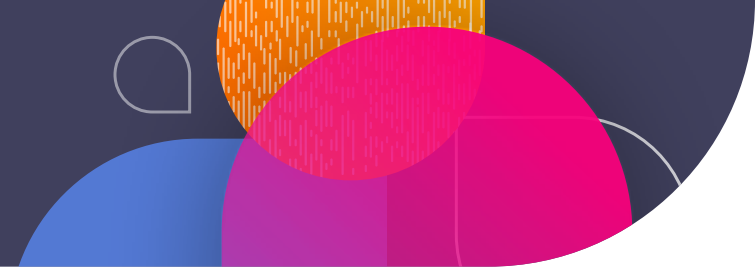
